Almost all the objects around us are made of plastic, glass, paper and metal, that is, materials that can be recycled. Properly segregated waste can be used for the production of new articles, for example bottles, newspapers, benches in the park or bicycles.

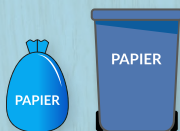

SELECTIVELY COLLECTED WASTE

PAPER AND CARDBOARD



- packaging made of paper, cardboard
- paper bags and sacks
- newspapers and magazines
- catalogues and leaflets
- office paper
- notebooks and books
- wrapping paper

METALS AND PLASTICS



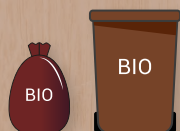
- drinks bottles and food packaging
- plastic bags, plastic shopping bags
- cleaning agent packaging
- multi-material packaging (e.g. milk, juice cartons)
- beverage and food cans
- small iron scrap
- styrofoam (non-construction)

GLASS



- drink and food glass bottles and jars
- glass cosmetics packaging (if they are not made of permanently connected several raw materials)

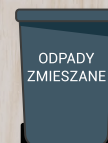
BIO



- vegetable and fruit waste (including peelings, etc.)
- food leftovers (without meat and bones)
- coffee and tea grounds

OTHER WASTE (MIXED)

- greasy paper
- dirty foils
- used towels and paper tissues
- varnished paper and paper coated with foil
- hygienic articles (e.g. diapers)
- table glass
- ceramics, porcelain, crystals
- heat-resistant glass
- mirrors
- meat, meat bones and fish bones



GREEN WASTE

- grass
- leaves
- shredded branches
- cut green parts of plants

Green waste can also be transferred to the PGOW Barycz waste collection point at 40 Krzemieniecka Point in Krakow.

MUNICIPAL WASTE SELECTIVE COLLECTION POINTS (PSZOK)

- PGOW Barycz (40 Krzemieniecka) Mon-Fri, 6.30 am to 6.00 pm, Saturdays 6.30 am to 2.00 pm

ELECTROSERVICE



- collection of electro waste directly from residents
- convenient collection dates
- this service can be arranged by calling 801 084 084

HAZARDOUS WASTE



- CDs, small electronics, batteries and light bulbs can be thrown into Krakow Eco-Boxes
- used needles, pre-filled syringes and expired medicines can be returned to a specialist MPO vehicle that will be located at the Krakow Eco-Box - dates of collection are given in the schedule on www.mpo.krakow.pl/ekopudelko
