GREEN WASTE

Green waste collection takes place according to the schedule available on the website: https://mpo.krakow.pl/odbior-odpadow-zielonych. On the collection day resulting from the schedule, the bag filled with green waste should be placed in front of the property, in a publicly accessible place (roadside, sidewalk) visible from the street until 7 am.

BULKY WASTE

Collection of bulky waste from single-family housing takes place on the basis of individual notifications sent to the MPO in Kraków, on dates agreed with the employees of the MPO. In the case of multi-family buildings applications should be sent by the property administrator.

ELECTROBRIGADE ON CALL

Large electronic waste (such as refrigerators, washing machines, TVs, etc.) is collected directly from residents on an agreed date. Contact: by phone or online application form.

UNNECESSARY TEXTILES

Textiles that are suitable for use and those that are damaged can be left at Municipal Waste Selective Collection Points. Textiles that are suitable for use are also collected from residents after a telephone notification or via an online notification form. Damaged textiles can be left additionally within the bulky waste collection program. Details on the website: https://mpo.krakow.pl/tekstylia.

KRAKÓW ECO-BOXES

"Kraków Eco-Boxes" are containers placed throughout the city for small electronic waste (light bulbs, batteries, CDs, power supplies, etc.). In addition, at each "Eco-Box", twice a month, a car of the Municipal Cleaning Company is on duty, where used syringes, needles and expired medicines can be left. MUNICIPAL WASTE SELECTIVE COLLECTION POINTS (PSZOK)

In two Municipal Waste Selective Collection Points (PSZOK): Lamusownia – 1D Nowohucka and PGOW Barycz – 40 Krzemieniecka, residents of Krakow can leave construction waste, bulky waste, hazardous waste, tires, textiles and segregated secondary raw materials without any additional fees. Details are available on the website: https://mpo.krakow.pl/pszok.

REMEMBER!

Waste segregation is **OBLIGATORY**.

Before visiting the Municipal Waste Selective Collection Point, read the regulations available on the website.

Owners of single-family houses, who compost bio-waste in their own compost bins, may be exempted from part of the municipal waste management fee.

DO NOT throw household waste into street bins!

Dog owners are required to clean up after their pets.

PRINCIPLES OF WASTE SEGREGATION



METALS AND PLASTICS

YELLOW CONTAINER / YELLOW BAG

- empty plastic bottles and food packaging
- plastic bags
- empty packaging of cleaning agents
- empty beverage or food metal cans
- empty multi-material packaging (e.g. drink cartons)
- non-construction styrofoam
- kitchen metal and plastic cookware and cutlery
- jar lids and caps
- empty deodorant cans

GLASS

GREEN CONTAINER / GREEN BAG

- empty glass drink bottles
- glass jars for drinks and food
- empty cosmetics glass packaging (if they are not made of several raw materials permanently combined)

PAPER

BLUE CONTAINER / BLUE BAG

- · ofiice paper
- · notebooks, books
- newspapers, magazines
- · paper bags (dry, not greasy)
- paper egg cartons (not soiled)
- wrapping paper (dry, not greasy)
- · leaflets, folders
- · packaging made of paper, cardboard

BIO

BROWN CONTAINER / BROWN BAG

WASTE SHOULD BE THROWN WITHOUT PACKAGING

- vegetable and fruit waste
- egg shells
- fruit cores and pits
- shells from nuts, sunflowers, etc.
- · food leftovers (without meat, bones)
- · coffee and tea grounds
- bread leftovers
- · cut and potted flowers (without soil)

MIXED WASTE

BLACK (GREY) CONTAINER

Other waste except non-typical and hazardous

- greasy paper
- · used paper towels and tissues
- used personal hygiene items (e.g. diapers)
- foil permanently dirty
- table glass, heat-resistant glass
- mirrors
- ceramics, porcelain, crystals
- leftover meat and cold cuts, bones

GREEN WASTE

SPECIALLY MARKED BAGS

- grass, leaves
- cut green parts of plants
- shredded branches
